# flooring accessories

## skirting lights

Not just an accessory but a great way to introduce low level lighting into your home. Projecting light back into your room or across a hallway, skirting lights create a subtle spread of lighting over your laminate wood floor. Available in a choice of colours: amber, white and blue.

## door thresholds

When laying a laminate floor in your home a door threshold room divider may be necessary. This enables a neat finish between rooms where your laminate floor meets another floor covering, and also allows for the natural expansion of your laminate floor. Available in 90cm length gold colour thresholds, they provide a laminate-to-laminate or laminate-to-carpet solution.

# underlay

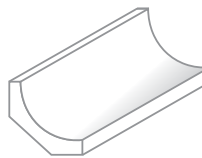
Underlay provides a soft base for your laminate flooring, with the added benefits of reducing noise between floors and acting as a thermal insulating layer. Each roll of underlay will cover an area of 25m<sup>2</sup> and to a depth of 2mm. A damp proof membrane (DPM) must be laid down first where the supporting floor is anything other than wood.

## scotia bead

A really neat finish for your floor is to apply a Scotia bead around the edges of your room. Available in 15mm x 15mm x 2.4m lengths.

Resistant protective overlay film, fused with a resinated decorative film into an abrasion-proof & hardwearing surface.

HDF fibreboard forms the supportive core (HDF, E1).

On the undersurface of the core a dampness impeding stabilisation film ensures and preserves the high structural stability of **Kronotex** laminates.

All tongue-in-groove profiles are treated with a protective wax compound for protection against dampness and climatic influence.
